Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and progra	ims.	The COVID-19 pandemic has posed many challenges in the education system at all levels in terms of academic schedule, admission process, mode of conduct of classes, method of teaching, the conduct of examination, organizing activities, and completion of the syllabus in time, during the academic year 2020-21. The following measures were undertaken by our institution to complete the syllabus of courses and programs: 1.As per the Goa University notification, the academic year 2020-21 commenced from 1st September 2020. 2.After completion of the online admission process through the DHE Portal, the Time Table Committee provided the timetable for the smooth conduct of online regular classes due to the COVID-19 pandemic. 3.The College has a Wi-Fi-enabled campus and ICT-enabled classrooms to facilitate the online teaching-learning process. 4.To complete the syllabus and courses the faculty made the best use of the ICT-enabled tools in their teaching process with the help of Google Meet, Zoom, Microsoft Teams, and other tools. The faculty were trained to acquire the knowledge and skills to use new digital tools to help all students to achieve high academic standards. 5. The faculty uploaded the course outcome, teaching plan and its compliance, and attendance of students on the DHE's IAIMS Portal. 6. Lecture Plans and PowerPoint presentations including data, videos, diagrams, and charts have been used in Google classrooms which helps an active interaction with the students and keeps them updated with the latest developments.
