A meeting of IQAC was held on 18th December 2021 at 10.30 a.m. onwards to discuss the following.

Agenda 1. Read and approve the minutes of the previous meeting

Chairman, IQAC, Principal Dr. Sanjay P. Sawant Dessai, welcomed all the members. The minutes of meeting held on 28th November 2020 were read by Dr. Apoorva A. Marathe, coordinator, IQAC.

Compliance of minutes:

- 1. The AQAR of 2019-20 was successfully uploaded on NAAC website on 21st December 2020.
- 2. NSS Unit stitched and distributed masks from time to time during 2021 in Cuncolim market and surrounding areas.
- 3. Formation of Consumers Co-operative Society by including members of the school, higher secondary and college section is in process.
- 4. College has activated QR Code and UPI ID Payment Facility for CES Students to make payment of fess through mobile phone.
- 5. Automation of Library.
- 6. Marathi DSC at the second year has been introduced.

The minutes were approved after discussion, proposed by Asso. Prof. Teja M.N. Gaunekar and seconded by Asst. Prof. Pooja Prabhudessai.

Agenda 2. Presentation of AQAR 2020-21

The co-ordinator, IQAC made presentation of AQAR 2020-21 before the committee. All necessary changes were made according to inputs given after discussion. The AQAR for the year 2020-21 was approved by the IQAC.

Agenda 3. Review of activities of the academic year 2020-21

The presentation of activities undertaken during academic year 2020-21 were presented.

- 1. It included process of promotion of four faculty members under CAS during November to March 20-21, Participation in project of NAAC, workshop on faculty development were organised by IQAC. Format of Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) has been revised and survey is conducted. Feedback formats have been revised, feedback is collected and analyzed.
- 2. Workshops on Konkani syllabus and project report writing for Hindi and Konkani subjects for students were organised .Several NSS / NCC activities, Students Council activities and quiz competitions were organised.
- 3. Online **Quiz on Awareness on Cooperatives was organised for** Students and Stakeholders in November 2020 using Google Forms.
- 4. A webinar for CES Students on 'Blogging as self employment- strategies to earn online', in June 2021 as well as a webinar on "Career opportunities after Graduation" for the students of T.Y.B.Com. in February 2021 were organised.
- 5. An Inter-Collegiate Online Essay competition was organised in April 2021 where 32 students from Goa participated .To promote creativitity among students "Creative Advertisement -Video Making Competition" for undergraduate students of Goa was conducted.
- 6. Online Quiz competitions on the life of Mahatma Gandhi ,Subhash Chandra Bose, and Goa Kranti Din as well as Cuncolim Revolt were organized during the academic year. The webinars on "Life of Shivaji" and "Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav" were organised in 2021.
- 7. A State level intercollegiate online "Kavi Sammelan" was organised on 26th June 2021 attended by eight colleges and Goa University.
- 8. Online counselling sessions and online and offline mentoring meetings following SOP were conducted.
- 9. Several NSS, NCC Activities have been conducted, cleanliness, hygiene, creating health awareness and distribution of Masks amongst the local people were the main areas of thrust during COVID period.

Broad initiatives of IQAC for 2022-23 were discussed . These included

Upgradation of use of ICT and necessary training for all faculty members, new smart class-room. Collection, analysis and necessary action on all stakeholders feedback, taken.

CAS initiatives to ensure efficiency at faculty levels.

To promote the quality education amongst students career counseling and internship programmes, Personality development workshops ,organization of seminars, organization of
