

Minutes of the IQAC meeting 19th November 2022

Minutes of meeting all IQAC members held on 19-11-2022 at 10.30 a.m. onwards in Smart Class Room (room no.20) of the College.

At the beginning Principal welcomed all members present at the meeting and agenda was taken for discussion .


