Guidelines for Counseling and Preparation of Merit List for Admission 2025-2026

- From Friday, 2nd May 2025, the colleges can scrutinize the applications and prepare the merit list.
- 12 prescribed by Goa University. Each college shall notify all applicants who have applied for the BBA and examinations programs at their respective institutions and conduct the entrance for these programs in accordance with the guidelines

- 7 on 14th May 2025 by 12.00 noon. All colleges should submit the soft copy of the merit list to the DHE office
- ∞ college website on Thursday, 15th May 2024. All the colleges should strictly declare the merit list on their respective
- 9 telephone after declaring the merit list. colleges may inform the short-listed applicants through email or
- 10. The counselling of candidates shall start from Friday, 16th May 2025.
- 11. The candidates need to produce original documents (especially Leaving Certificate) at the time of admission.
- 12. The colleges should counsel the candidates in detail on the NEP 2020 course structure before confirming the admission.
- 13.On submitting the valid documents and payment of fees, colleges should update the status of the admitted candidates immediately on the SAMARTH
- 14.The prescribed). passing percentage colleges shall prepare the Merit list strictly based on the 12th (wherever the entrance exam or. interview 1S not
- 15.The also prepare the waiting list of all the remaining candidates to avoid confusion among the candidates colleges shall display the merit list as per the approved strength and

- 16. The colleges shall counsel the candidates to select the Minor, AEC, SEC, MC, VAC) based on their preferences or availability of courses (Major,
- 17.If the candidate wishes to cancel his/her admission, college should return on the SAMARTH portal. his/her original documents and refund the fees paid as per the guidelines issued by the Goa University and update the same immediately
- 18.In case the colleges have seats vacant in the first round of counselling after the second round of admission. The date of the same will be informed later. exhausting all the candidates, the college will have a choice to participate in
- 19. Colleges can admit the candidate under management quota (strictly for college. This is due to the technical constraints in the SAMARTH who have not applied under the Samarth portal for the respective No separate window will be open for accommodating the candidates for the respective college within the online application window period. the candidate who has already applied online on the SAMARTH portal
- 20. If the college is participating in the second round of admission, the vacant category candidates. seats under the reserved category should not be filled by the General
- 21. Once the candidate confirms the seat and is admitted to any college, they their application form. the end of the first/second round of counselling will get a chance to edit However, a candidate who has not been admitted to any of the colleges by will not be able to edit their forms for the subsequent round of admission.
- 22. The counselling process is a continuous process. As and when the seats are vacant, the colleges can offer admission to the candidates on the waiting
- 23. The candidate will have only one chance to switch the college admission until the last date of the admission process.
- 24. The colleges should follow fair and transparent practices throughout the admission process
